Q&A

Q. What if I don't want to go to the game but want to attend Event #1?

A. The price of the event includes a ticket to the game and no discount will be given. It is up to the ticket holder to determine what they want to do with the ticket.

Q. I am a season ticket holder and do not need a ticket?

A. The price of the event includes a ticket to the game and no discount will be given. It is up to the ticket holder to determine what they want to do with the ticket.

Q. Do I need to attend Event #1 to attend Event #2?

A. No, additional tickets can be purchased to the game only.

Q. Who can attend Event #1?

A. Mom, Dad, Grandma, Grandpa, Aunt, Sister, and BFF's. All attendees must be at least 5 years old. No young boys (siblings) are allowed to attend the event. This night is all about THE GIRLS. The dads and grandpas are required to sleep in a separate area.

Q. Can I bring snacks and drinks to Event #1?

A. Snacks and drinks (no glass) are permitted in the party deck area ONLY. Troops will have a designated area to store food items. NO food or drinks are permitted on the field.

Q. What do I need to bring?

A. You will need to bring sleeping bags, overnight clothes toiletries and a pop-up tent unless you want to sleep directly under the stars. If your tent requires stakes, you will not be allowed to use the stakes (bricks work good).

Q. What if I get sick or want to leave before check-out?

A. We will have EMT's available and the gates will only be opened for emergencies. Troops/individuals will have the option to leave but will need to indicate ahead of time, see the question below.

Q. Do I have to stay the night?

A. No, you may leave at the end of the movie, approximately around 12:00 a.m. You will need to indicate on the roster individuals that are leaving before lights out. There is no discount given if you do not stay the night.

Q. What if it rains?

A. If it is a severe thunderstorm, the event will be re-scheduled for the rain date June 9, 2017. Otherwise, arrangements will be made and the event will not be cancelled.

Q. What if the event is cancelled and I can not attend the rain date?

A. No refunds will be given in the event you can not attend the rain date. You may substitute a person in your place by providing an updated roster along with any necessary paperwork.

Q. Are we going to work on any badges or activities?

A. No, this is socialization, relaxation event for the girls to dance, eat, and show their friend how much fun it is to be a Girl Scout.

Q. What time can we check-in?

A. Each troop will receive a check-in time between 4:30 p.m. – 6:15 p.m

Q. What time can we check-out?

A. Clean-up will begin at 6:00 a.m. and once your area has been signed off you can check-out. Breakfast will be served from 7:15 a.m. – 8:30 a.m.
