## Program Aide (Leadership Opportunity)

Program Aide: Teens who meet the prerequisite requirements may participate as Program Aides at our Day Camps. Program Aides learn camp and leadership skills through training. They apply this at camp with younger groups as they work towards Program Aide recognition and leadership hours. After placement in a Day Camp program, all Program Aides must attend mandatory trainings specific to the Day Camp they will be attending. Failure to attend these trainings will result in forfeiting their placement at the camp.

**Program Aide Prerequisites:**

- Completion of the 7th Grade
- Completion of GSCM's Program Aide and Outdoor Program Aide trainings
- Completion of Council-Directed Day Camp training
- Program Aide Registration Form and payment of the camp fee (\$25.00 per Day Camp)

## Be a Day Camp Volunteer (adults only)

GSCM is actively recruiting adults who are interested in serving as Volunteer Staff for the Day Camps. The camps will be volunteer-run camps.
