Whereas, the undersigned (The Camper) wishes to be accepted for participation in a special program or van transportation to be organized and conducted by the staff of Camp Conowingo; and, in consideration of Girl Scouts of Central Maryland's action in allowing the Camper to participate in such a program:

The undersigned Camper and the undersigned Parent(s)/Guardian(s) of the Camper acknowledge the Camp Conowingo resident camp program will necessarily subject the Camper to certain stresses and hazards, not all of which can be foreseen. REASONABLE PRECAUTIONS WILL BE TAKEN TO PROTECT THE CAMPER. IT IS UNDERSTOOD THAT UNFORESEEN CIRCUMSTANCES MAY OCCUR IN SPECIAL PROGRAMS FOR WHICH THE INSTRUCTOR OR GIRL SCOUTS OF CENTRAL MARYLAND CANNOT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE.

The undersigned Camper and Parent(s)/Guardian(s) assume all of the ordinary risks normally incidental to the nature of the program, including risks which are not specifically foreseeable. The undersigned Camper and Parent(s)/Guardian(s), for themselves and their respective heirs, personal representatives and assigns, hereby release Girl Scouts of Central Maryland, its staff, employees and agents from all liability of any nature for loss or damage to personal property. The undersigned Camper and Parent(s)/Guardian(s), for themselves and their respective heirs, personal representatives and assigns, further release Girl Scouts of Central Maryland, its staff, employees and agents from all liability for personal injury resulting from the failure of the undersigned Camper or other campers in the special program to obey safety regulations and directions of the leader, or resulting from the exercise of judgment of the leader in good faith in response to emergencies and exigencies which occur in the program, provided however, that nothing contained herein shall excuse any member of the staff, employees or agents, or person assigned to be a program leader by a member of the staff, from the responsibility to act with reasonable care for the safety of the undersigned Camper during the course of the program appropriate to the circumstances. It is the intention of the undersigned that this agreement will be governed by the laws of the state of Maryland.

Girl Scouts of Central Maryland has rules that we follow to make sure everyone has a safe and fun experience at camp. Our Camper Code of Conduct is based on the Girl Scout Promise and Girl Scout Law as our guide for behavior at Girl Scout Camps.

- I understand that the Camper Code of Conduct is in place to protect others and me and to help make sure camp is safe, fun and successful.
- I will treat other people, myself, property, and equipment with respect.
- I will follow the principles of the Girl Scout Promise and Law.

<p><b>The Girl Scout Promise</b> On my honor, I will try; To serve God and my country, To help people at all times, And to live by the Girl Scout Law.</p>
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<p><b>The Girl Scout Law</b> I will do my best to be honest and fair, friendly and helpful, considerate and caring, courageous and strong, and responsible for what I say and do, and to respect myself and others, respect authority, use resources wisely, make the world a better place, and be a sister to every Girl Scout.</p>
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While at camp your camper deserves to have fun, try new things, make new friends and enjoy the camp experience in the spirit of Girl Scouting and feel physically and emotionally safe. No child's experience should be hindered by subtle or overt bullying. We have a firm policy against all types of verbal, physical and relational bullying.

I understand the following are unacceptable behaviors:

- Verbal abuse of anyone for any reason;
- Threatening of, or any physical abuse and fighting;
- Stealing or damaging property;
- The creation of alliances and written or verbal contracts used to exclude anyone at anytime for any reason;
- Teasing and gossiping.

The camp staff strives to create a successful and positive camp experience for every girl. Girl Scouts of Central Maryland reserves the right to send any girl home that exhibits unsafe and/or unacceptable behavior that endangers other girls, staff or property. Parents/guardians will be notified and are responsible for picking up the girl immediately from camp. Persons listed as emergency contacts may be notified if parents/guardian cannot be reached. No refund will be given if a camper is sent home due to unacceptable or inappropriate behavior.

Both the camper and parent/guardian have read, understand and agree to comply with the Code of Conduct Agreement while at Girl Scout camp.
