**Girl Scouts' P.A.V.E. (Project Anti-Violence Education) the Way Baltimore Peer Counselors Participate in June 30<sup>th</sup> Tools 4 Success Workshop**

Baltimore—At a time when violence among teens is becoming more and more prevalent some local teens will be working together at the Loyola Graduate Center in Timonium on Saturday, June 30, 2007, to strategize about how they can avoid and deter this kind of behavior. Girl Scouts of Central Maryland's (GSCM) P.A.V.E. peer counselors will be partnering with the Baltimore County Police Department to help teens identify ways they can become successful and not fall prey to the afflictions that teens are often confronted with.

Through the *Tools 4 Success Workshops* teens will address: peer pressure; conflict resolution and problem solving; gang prevention; and confidence and self-esteem. GSCM's P.A.V.E. peer counselors will also be performing their seven-minute play "A Daily Drama" which depicts the coercive devices teens can fall prey to, and the ways they can avoid them. The workshop, which takes place from 9:00 a.m. – 2:30 p.m., is open to children ages 11-18. Parent sessions are also offered.
