### Girl Scouts Elects Three New Members to Board of Directors

Baltimore—Retired attorney **Robert E. Giovagnoni, Esq.**, who served as General Counsel for the President’s Commission on Critical Infrastructure Protection as well as Air Force Office of Special Investigations to Solicitor General for the Air Force and Military Judge; **Judy McGovern**, owner and president of RealStreet Staffing as well as longtime Girl Scout volunteer serving as a leader, Delegate Chair and Family SHARE coordinator; and **Lori Trumble**, who is an active fund development volunteer for organizations that include the Catholic Charity, Notre Dame Preparatory School and the Children’s Guild, as well as a lifetime Girl Scout member, former leader and Council Delegate, were elected to the Girl Scouts of Central Maryland Board of Directors during the Council’s annual meeting in late May. Mr. Giovagnoni and Ms. Trumble will serve three-year terms; Ms. McGovern will serve a one-year-term.
