- GSCM Program Activity; i.e. GS411
- Troop planned event

## SAMPLE – NOT CURRENTLY SPONSORED FINANCIAL AID ITEMS

**Girls:** Girl Scout Membership Registration fees, books, troop dues, uniforms, activities for the entire program year.

**Troops:** Non GSCM sponsored trips or events  
Must demonstrate a connection to program/Girl Scout Leadership Experience.

**Adults:** Girl Scout Membership Registration fees, books, uniforms
