GREAT ADVENTURES at Girl Scouts resident camp...Listed on the pages that follow are Girl Scouts of Central Maryland's Summer Camp opportunities at our resident camp headquarters, Camp Conowingo. Camp Conowingo is located in Conowingo, MD, approximately one-hour northeast of Baltimore City. The camp is situated on 600 acres of woodlands and open fields along the Susquehanna River. While the camp is primitive in some aspects, it allows campers to connect with their natural surroundings. Campers live in yurts, glen shelters, platform tents, teepees, covered wagons, or lodges.

Within each unit are sleeping facilities, kitchen shelters, latrines, cold-water hand washing stations, and a campfire area. Each sleeping unit, other than when the campers are tent camping, is equipped with a cot and mattress for sleeping. Most units do not have electricity. The air-conditioned dining hall, bathhouse and swimming pool areas boast modern facilities. *Note:* Staff members sleep in separate areas within the unit, and are centrally located within the unit to which they are assigned.
