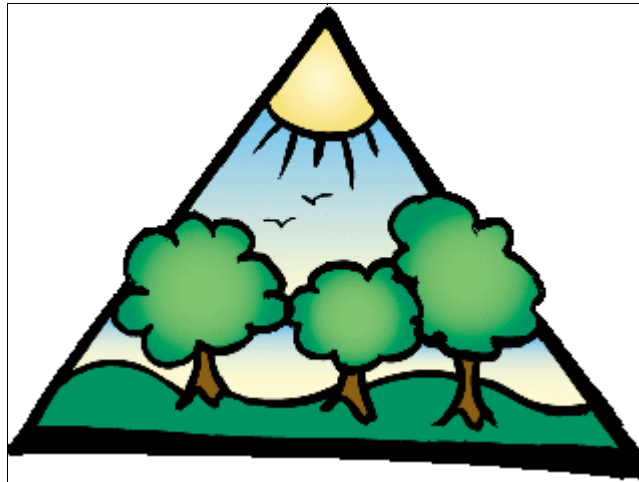

___ **Ceremonies** – Bring zip to your ceremonies. Practice variations of four traditional scout ceremonies – Scouts Own, Court of Awards, Investiture and Rededication. Participants are encouraged to share ideas!

___ **Field Trips (Inexpensive Ways to Move Out)** - Stuck in your meeting place? Find out where to take your girls on a low-dollar budge. Come to share and pick up new and practiced easy field trips.

___ **Recycled Art to Wear** – Is that “junk” piling up? Join with others in this make and take workshop to make jewelry from recycled materials.

Session III 3:00 – 4:30

___ **Songs** – Are your girls asking to sing and they only repeat the same two or three songs? Bring a portable recorder (optional) and join others in this rollicking song experience.

___ **Bridging** – that special ceremony that celebrates moving from one level to another! Learn how to incorporate bridging activities into your troop meetings, culminating in a special ceremony. Appropriate for all age levels.

___ **Progression in the Out-of-Doors** – Overwhelmed by the idea of overnight camping? Learn easy steps to introduce your girls to the out-of-doors and basic camping skills. Share ideas aimed at a progression from short day trips to overnight camping.
