



Assistant Camp Ranger

POSITION SUMMARY

The Assistant Camp Ranger is a full time position at Camp Conowingo, located in Cecil county. The position provides general maintenance services under the direction of the camp Ranger at Camp Conowingo and at other sites as directed. The Assistant Ranger's primary responsibility is to maintain the health and safety standards of the camp in a timely and organized manner.

POSITION PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Having knowledge of basic skills of carpentry, plumbing, electrical systems, grounds maintenance and janitorial services, the position assists and supports the camp Ranger in the maintaining of grounds, roads, buildings, machinery, equipment, tools and supplies. The position sets up, opens and closes facilities as scheduled, routinely checks grounds, buildings, and equipment for repairs and safety hazards while ensuring camp security, and takes action if there are violations noted. Other duties may be assigned as needed or requested.

POSTION REQUIREMENTS

Education and/or Relevant Experience:

- High school or GED equivalent required with post-high school education preferred;
- Prior experience working in a maintenance position
- Ability to use various tools (i.e. lawn mowers, weed eater, hedge clippers, circular saws, drills, hand tools, etc.)
- Ability to plan and carry out work under general supervision.
- Able to interact with diverse volunteers, staff and governmental entities
- Available to work varied hours/days as business dictates; some weekends and nights required.
- Valid driver's license and the ability to provide proof of insurance required.
- Must be able to lift and push up to 50 lbs.
- Exposure to all types of weather and climate conditions may occur when required to assist with ground maintenance.
- Exposure to mechanical power equipment, and cleaning chemicals/solutions on a daily basis.
- Ability to comprehend and follow established safe material handling procedures.
